	Unvaccinated HCW/No COVID-19 infection within previous 180 days	Vaccinated† HCW/Confirmed COVID-19 infection within previous 180 days
HCW Returning from Travel	If HCW has a negative RT-PCR result from a test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival into the country, HCW can attend work. Quarantine no longer applies	HCW does not require restricted movement or testing and can attend work.
